#### ABOUT OAK MOUNTAIN SHOW CHOIR CREW

The Oak Mountain Show Choir Crew is a crucial part of the choral department. The crew performs with the show choirs — The Singers & The Muses. In the past this includes our Holiday Spectacular, competition show choir shows, and annual Dessert Cabaret.

The desire of the Oak Mountain High School Choral Department is to enable students to develop self-discipline, leadership abilities, communication skills and, above all else, to make memories which will last a lifetime in the environment of a "second family". Additionally, show choir crew members are provided an opportunity to perform with outside community groups, and for aid in technical aspects for theater productions and the annual musical.

#### **REHEARSALS & PERFORMANCES**

The Crew meets for a class period each day and learns theater maintenance, audio and visual skills, along with sewing, building, and painting skills. These tasks are applied to all aspects for the show choir shows and productions being performed in the Performing Arts Center. While this class does meet during the school day there are after-school rehearsals to allow the crew and choirs rehearse together. Show Choir Crew members are expected to spend time wisely making sure their jobs are done to the highest level in preparation to running a professional show. The crew, band, and choir members travel together to various weekend competitions during second semester (typically three weekends), as well as a possible winter trip. The show choirs and crew also perform at the in-school shows, and any community performances.
